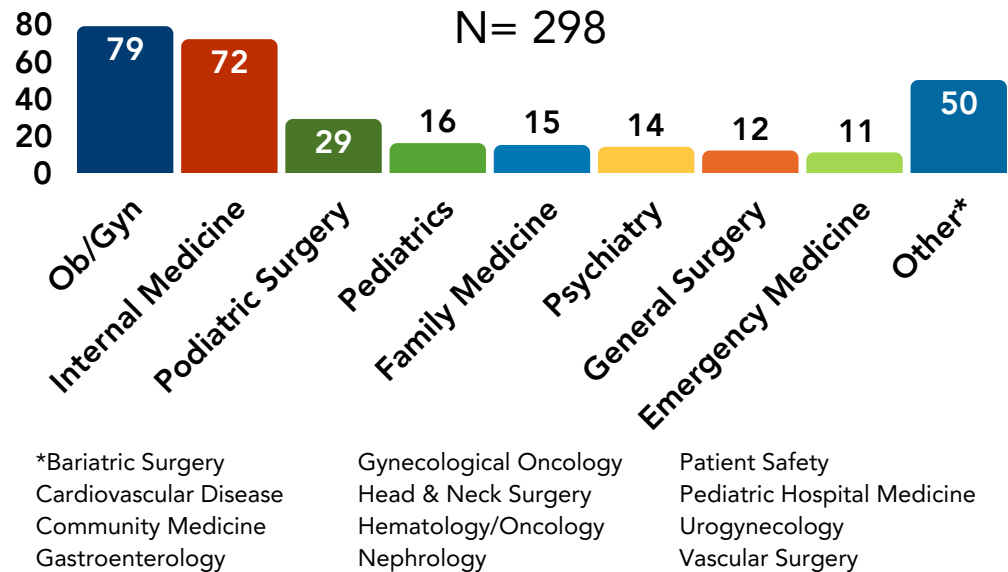


Graduate Medical Education Research

2024 Executive Summary

In 2024, Kaiser Permanente Northern California Graduate Medical Education invested over \$3.2 million to support research in its 19 residency programs and 18 fellowship programs. Nearly 300 scholarly projects and 100 scholarly products were produced with support from the Division of Research BSCU.

Projects Supported by Trainee Specialty



Projects addressed a range of needs, including:

- Identifying risk factors
- Evaluating treatment effectiveness
- Addressing disparities in health care
- Using advanced analytics and predictive modeling
- Optimizing resource use

Scholarly products and examples of high-impact venues:

- 28 manuscripts, including in JAMA Network Open, Journal of the American Heart Association, and Journal of the National Comprehensive Cancer Network
- 65 conference presentations, including at the American Association for Cancer Research, American College of Cardiology, and American College of Gastroenterology annual meetings
