

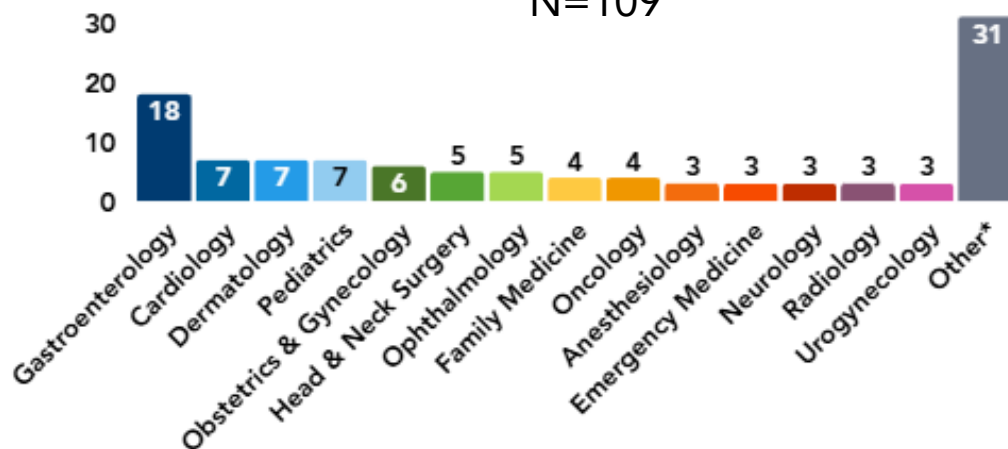
Community Health Research

2025 Executive Summary

In 2025, the Kaiser Permanente Northern California Central Research Committee provided over \$1.3 million Community Health dollars to support research aligned with community health priorities. Over 100 scholarly projects and nearly 40 scholarly products were produced with support from the Division of Research BSCU.
